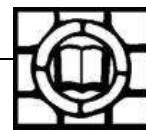

A book with one author:

Cianciolo, Patricia J. *Picture Books for Children*. Chicago: ALA, 1997. Print.

A book with several authors:

Sutherland, Zena, Betsy Hearne, and Roger Sutton. *The Authors: Best in Children's Books, 1985-1990*. Chicago: U of Chicago, 1991. Print.

A book with author and editor: (Cite normally, but add the editor after the title).

Bronte, Charlotte. *Jane Eyre*. Ed. Margaret Smith. Oxford: Oxford UP, 1998. Print.

An edited book:

Benson, Stephen, ed. *Contemporary Fiction and the Fairy Tale*. Detroit : Wayne State UP, 2008. Print.

An article or chapter in an edited book:

Anglo, Sydney. "Humanism and the Court Arts." *Impact of Humanism on Western Europe*. Ed. Anthony Goodman. London: Longman, 1990. Print.

An article in a print periodical:

Author(s). "Title of Article." *Title of Journal* Volume. Issue (year): pages. Medium of publication.

Smith, Peter. "What Makes a Good Curriculum?" *Early Childhood Today* 12.4 (1965): 3-9. Print.

An article from an online database:

Estep, James Riley, Jr. "Faith as the Transformer of Learning: Toward an Evangelical Approach to Faith-Learning Integration in Christian Higher Education." *Christian Education Journal* 2.2 (1998): 59-76. *ATLA Religion Database*. EBSCO. Web. 23 Nov. 2009.

A Web page:
