GENEVA COLLEGE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

A \$1,000 Geneva College Scholarship will be awarded to all participants in the Henry Mancini Musical Theatre Awards who apply and meet the following guidelines.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- **Must be a junior or senior in high school**
- **Must attend Geneva College in the fall after high school graduation**
- **Must participate in a musical entered in the Mancini Awards in the calendar year in which they are applying for scholarship. (This will include cast, sets, tech, orchestra and crew.)**
- **Must meet the academic requirements of the admissions office of Geneva College.**

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP ARE AS FOLLOWS

- **\$1,000 will be awarded to eligible freshmen Geneva students who have met the standards outlined above. (This is a one-time scholarship.)**
- **Scholarship will be awarded in addition to any other Geneva scholarship already received as long as those scholarships combined do not exceed the cost of tuition.**
- **Applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2011.**
- **Juniors previously awarded this scholarship may not re-apply in their senior year.**
