This is more than a catchy slogan. After 100 years, we will enter into a new era for 2011 having full membership in the NCAA and the Presidents Athletic Conference. It is an exciting change as Geneva will renew some old-time rivalries with regional schools as the Golden Tornadoes seek their first PAC championship.

Also marking this new era is a completed renovation of Reeves Field, Geneva's aging stadium. The project included a Pro-Grass turf surface, new seating, press box, entrance and scoreboard. Reeves is the finest facility in the conference and is already considered one of the best venues in the nation to watch Saturday night college football. Although we have changed conferences and affiliations, and we have upgraded our facilities, one thing has not changed. It is our commitment to be excellent.

Our players are surrounded by a coaching staff that is dedicated to encouraging them academically and spiritually as well as athletically. We have placed more players on conference all-scholar teams and have had more national scholar-athletes than ever before. The heart of our program is best captured in Romans 8:37: “In all these things we are more than conquerors in Christ.”

This is a great time to be a part of Golden Tornadoes football, “where tradition demands an expectation of excellence.”

A TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE SINCE 1890

- Played in the first Orange Bowl in 1926.
- Alumnus Cal Hubbard, a 1927 graduate, is the only person honored in NFL and MLB football and baseball Halls of Fame.
- Played in the first nighttime college game in 1947.
- Ranked number one nationally in 1998.
- Ranked nationally in the “Top 30” for 13 of the last 17 seasons.
- One of only 26 NCAA DIII schools to win 500 games.
- Postseason opportunities 11 of the last 15 years.
- Coach Gene DeMarco ranks 18th in win percentage among all coaches in the eastern United States. This includes over 250 schools in every level of college competition. Where the coach has a minimum of 10 years at the school. He is Geneva's all-time winningest coach.
- Produced 66 All-Americans in the last 27 years and 44 in the last 17.
- \$3.5 million renovation to historic 6,500-seat Reeves Field.
- Coach DeMarco and his staff garnered Coach of the Year Honors nine times.
- Coach DeMarco finished in the “Top 5” of national fan voting for the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year award.
- In 2010 Geneva set a home attendance record averaging 6000 fans per game.
- In 2009 Geneva recorded its 4th NCCAA national championship by winning the Victory Bowl for the 5th time.

HISTORY Geneva, a private four-year Christian college of the liberal arts and sciences, was founded in 1848 by the Reformed Presbyterian Church of North America in Northwood, Ohio. In 1880 we were moved to our current campus in historic Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania.

LOCATION Our 55-acre campus is situated in the foothills of the Allegheny Mountains, only 35 miles from downtown Pittsburgh.

ENROLLMENT Of the nearly 1,400 undergraduate students who call Geneva home, 45 percent are male, 55 percent are female, and approximately 10 percent are ethnic minorities. We come from across the country and around the world, representing 35 states and 13 nations. Geneva also enrolls 300 graduate students and 350 undergraduate degree completion students.

ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT Since our student-to-professor ratio is 14 to 1, you're assured of one-on-one time with professors both during and outside of class.

FAITH TRADITION While our roots are Reformed, our students come from over 60 Christian denominations.

ATHLETICS Geneva's Golden Tornadoes compete in the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA Division III), the President's Athletic Conference, and the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA). Geneva offers men's baseball and football; softball, tennis and volleyball; and men's and women's basketball, cross country, soccer, and indoor/outdoor track and field.

NON-TRADITIONAL PROGRAMS At over 11 sites, we offer an adult degree completion program that allows students to finish a degree in human resources management, organizational development, community ministry or human services in 15 months. The Center for Urban Theological Studies and the Center for Urban Biblical Ministry are inner-city programs that train urban church leaders in ministry leadership.

GRADUATE PROGRAMS Geneva's offers master's degrees in business, counseling, higher education, organizational leadership, special education and reading.
