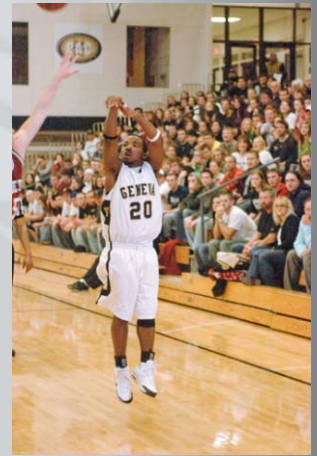

Geneva has the distinction of being the first institution to introduce the game of collegiate basketball in February 1893. We have built a strong tradition of success both on the court and in the classroom. Geneva College has moved to the NCAA Division III and participates in the Presidents Athletic Conference as well as the East Region of the National Christian College Athletic Association. It has been an exciting change as Geneva has renewed old-time rivalries with schools across Western Pennsylvania.

Along with a new conference, Metheny Fieldhouse has just had a new state of the art wood floor installed in the last four years and is one of the finest small college facilities in Western Pennsylvania. We have a great fan base support from our campus and community that provides a great atmosphere for college basketball. Our players are surrounded by a coaching staff that is dedicated to encouraging academically and spiritually as well as athletically. We have a 100% graduation rate in the basketball program of those student-athletes who have come through our program. We take pride in helping young men gain an education that will prepare them for life and giving them the opportunity to excel in a successful basketball program.

HISTORY Geneva, a private four-year Christian college of the liberal arts and sciences, was founded in 1848 by the Reformed Presbyterian Church of North America in Northwood, Ohio. In 1880 we were moved to our current campus in historic Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania.

LOCATION Our 55-acre campus is situated in the foothills of the Allegheny Mountains, only 35 miles from downtown Pittsburgh.

ENROLLMENT Of the nearly 1,400 undergraduate students who call Geneva home, 45 percent are male, 55 percent are female, and approximately 10 percent are ethnic minorities. We come from across the country and around the world, representing 35 states and 13 nations. Geneva also enrolls 300 graduate students and 350 undergraduate degree completion students.

ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT Since our student-to-professor ratio is 14 to 1, you're assured of one-on-one time with professors both during and outside of class.

FAITH TRADITION While our roots are Reformed, our students come from over 60 Christian denominations.

ATHLETICS Geneva's Golden Tornadoes compete in the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA Division III), the President's Athletic Conference, and the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA). Geneva offers men's baseball and football; softball, tennis and volleyball; and men's and women's basketball, cross country, soccer, and indoor/outdoor track and field.

NON-TRADITIONAL PROGRAMS At over 11 sites, we offer an adult degree completion program that allows students to finish a degree in human resources management, organizational development, community ministry or human services in 15 months. The Center for Urban Theological Studies and the Center for Urban Biblical Ministry are inner-city programs that train urban church leaders in ministry leadership.

GRADUATE PROGRAMS Geneva's offers master's degrees in business, counseling, higher education, organizational leadership, special education and reading.
