- Geneva grants/scholarships may be prorated (file 12-13 FAFSA form at www.fafsa.gov)
- Federal grants may be available (file 12-13 FAFSA form at www.fafsa.gov)
- PHEAA grant money may be available (complete Summer Application in April at www.pheaa.org)
- **Please be prepared to pay out of pocket for summer classes before they begin.** If you are interested in borrowing a PLUS or Private Loan, be sure to apply before May. More information about loan options can be found at www.geneva.edu/fa.

Please Remember:

- You will need to pay for your books out of pocket. Some financial aid does not disburse until later in the summer, so you cannot expect a refund check before classes begin.
- **Geneva Grants and Scholarships** are not available in the summer unless:
 - Student will graduate in fewer than eight semesters and is attending full-time in the summer in order to finish early.
 - Student is full-time attending the May-June block as part of an education degree.
- To receive a **PA State Grant**, a separate application must be filed online with PHEAA at www.pheaa.org. Please know that a summer grant counts toward the maximum 8 semesters of grant offered by PHEAA. If you are unsure whether or not to use a semester of state grant eligibility for summer, please contact our office.
- To receive a **Federal Pell Grant** in the summer, you must take at least 3 credits, be eligible based on the FAFSA, and be a December Graduate.
- To receive a **Direct Loan**, you must be enrolled for at least 6 credits. Federal Direct Loans are given on a yearly basis. If loan money is used in the summer, there will be less available for the fall and spring terms. Please see below for the annual Direct Loan maximum amounts.
