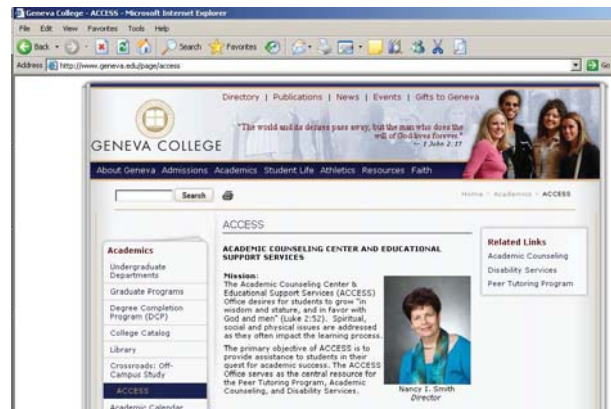

WHO WE ARE

The Academic Counseling Center & Educational Support Services (ACCESS) Office is an outgrowth of Geneva's mission to educate a diverse community of students for the purpose of developing servant-leaders. Our specific tasks are to:

- Promote successful independent learning.
- Identify and enhance academic strengths.
- Develop strategies for overcoming academic weaknesses.
- Help students understand God's call to discipline their minds.
- Complement faculty efforts to help students achieve their potential.

ACCESS is available to ALL students who desire assistance in achieving their educational GOALS.

WHAT WE DO

Opportunities for students include peer tutoring, study-skills inventory, disability services and more:

- One-on-One Academic Counseling.
- Trained peer tutors are available one hour per week per course, excluding some new and some upper-level courses. Students may apply in the ACCESS Office.
- Study Skills Inventory, a web based program, to determine study skills strengths and weaknesses.
- Learning Plus is a diagnostic and tutorial software program focusing on reading, writing and math.
- Reasonable accommodations for disabilities are available to students who present professional documentation and meet with the director of ACCESS.
- Disability screening and testing is available.
- Study strategy development available through study skills workshops.
