Frequently asked Questions

▶ Who can apply?

- 1. Any student may apply for their junior year.
- 2. A Major in Communication is NOT required. However, the Crossroads advisor must approve a student for AIP.
- 3. Students with an independent major will be assigned a discipline specific advisor to track progress toward graduation. The Geneva College registrar will also keep a copy of the student's approved courses and complete the graduation audit based upon that list.

What minors are available?

Geneva College will accept the following Minors:

Advertising, Entertainment Design, Fashion/Retail Mgmt., Fashion Design, Game art Design, Graphic Design, Industrial Design, Interior Design, Media Arts & Animation, Photography, Visual Effects & Motion Graphics

▶ When should a student begin the application process?

So his/her time at Geneva College is used wisely, a student should talk to their academic advisor as soon as they think they are interested in the program.

► How are the AIP credits transferred back to Geneva College?

Thirty (30) credits are earned for the three term program. The Crossroads advisor will approve courses accepted for credit prior to the beginning of the program.

▶ What is the academic calendar?

AIP operates on a 4 term-session calendar:

October - December

January - March

April – June

July - September

May I take only 2 terms?

Yes – A student may take part in the July-September and October-December terms.

May I take the 4th term offered by AIP as a Geneva College student?

No. A student may however, graduate from Geneva College and then return to AIP for the 4th term at their own expense.

How are students billed?

- Students attending the **3 term** AIP program will be invoiced each GC semester for the regular GC tuition.
- Students participating in 2 terms will be billed on their GC fall semester invoice, the AIP cost for 2 terms
- All participants will be charged a \$300 Off-Campus study fee. This will be added to their student invoice.
- Room & board will be charged on a case/case basis.
 - 1. Students living on Geneva's campus will be charged for their room and may take a smaller meal plan.
 - 2. Those wishing to live on their own in Pittsburgh will not be charged R&B.
 - 3. Those wishing to live in the AIP residence halls will be billed for their R&B separately by AIP

▶ How will my financial aid be determined?

The use of Geneva's financial aid will be determined by the student's program of study at Geneva. State & Federal aid may be applied to study at AIP. **Meet with Geneva's Financial Aid** office to discuss your particular financial situation and complete the Cost Estimate Worksheet.

▶ If I choose to live on campus, do I receive financial help with commuting to Pittsburgh?

► May I change my mind about my courses once I enroll?

Only under special circumstances. Students must petition and receive permission from both the Crossroads advisor and their academic advisor for permission before making *ANY* changes.
