

To help adults who are seeking an accredited bachelor's degree, Geneva is offering a Step Forward Grant of up to \$9,000 off the total cost of tuition for any major, either classroom-based or fully online.

The Step Forward Grant, which is awarded at a rate of up to \$2,250 per term, provides additional financial assistance for adult students who are ready to invest in a Geneva College education. To qualify, a student must begin classes in the 2015 spring semester, between January 1 and April 20, 2015, and enroll in at least 12 credits. The amount of the grant may be superseded by another grant or scholarship.

Additional financial aid is available to many students enrolling in the Adult Degree Programs. Be sure to speak to your enrollment counselor to understand the various loans, grants and scholarships available. If you are a service member, a member of Phi Theta Kappa, or eligible for tuition reimbursement from your employer, let your enrollment counselor know to ensure the best possible financial aid.

Announcing a New Major!

The Department of Professional & Leadership Studies is excited to announce its new fully online Bachelor of Science in Child and Family Services (CFS). Child and Family Services is a broad-based degree that encompasses classes in human services, psychology and child welfare to equip today's professional in working with children and their family in a wide context of settings. Graduates of the CFS program can go on to careers as a Children's Advocate Coordinator, Children's Librarian, Day Care Center Director, Early Childhood Interventionist, Family Day-Care Provider, Family Resource Coordinator, Recreation Center Director and more.

According to John Gallo, Dean of Graduate, Adult, and Online Programs, the CFS degree is unique in that its focus is to examine how a family functions not just internally in terms of the developing child, but in the community and society as well. This is all done from a uniquely Christian perspective that emphasizes how scripture can help guide us in the development of healthy children and stable families.

One of the unique aspects of this program is the opportunity for experiential observation in a variety of settings. According to Gallo, "Students will be able to meet leaders and executive directors of child and family

organizations in their own communities, obtaining not just important practical experience that they will relate to course concepts, but also developing a key network of professional contacts that could lead to job opportunities after graduation."

The CFS program is fully online and it begins in February 2015. Geneva College now offers four fully online Adult Degree Programs (ADP)—Management, Human Resources, Organizational Leadership, and Child and Family Services.
