<sup>1</sup> ENG LIT students should NOT take ENG 101, as ENG 113 fulfills ENG 101 requirement

<sup>2</sup> The English Literature major is required to take either ENG 201 or ENG 205, not both

<sup>3</sup> English Diverse Voices: Students are required to take 3 credits from: ENG 290, ENG 335, ENG 336, or ENG 337 \*\*\* ENG 290 fulfills both the “Diverse Voices” English literature major requirement AND the SOCIETY-C CORE option; ENG 337 fulfills both the “Diverse Voices” English literature major requirement AND the SOCIETY-B CORE option

<sup>4</sup> The 2-credit “Theory to Practice” English Literature requirement may be fulfilled either by taking ENG 320: Tutoring Writing (2 credits), or by taking two of the following 1-credit courses: ENG 223, COM 209, or COM 201. These 1-credit courses need not be taken in the same semester. ENG 320 is offered only in fall semesters. The 1-credit courses are offered every semester.

<sup>5</sup> ENG 489 fulfills both the English Literature major Senior Seminar requirement AND the CORE Capstone requirement
