ADHD Paperwork Directions

Any student athlete that is currently taking prescription medications for ***Attention Deficit Disorder, Anxiety or Depression*** must have the following items below **ON-FILE** in the athletic training room. The medications normally prescribed for the above conditions can result in a positive NCAA drug test. The information is required to be On-File prior to any drug testing administration as athletic eligibility can be affected by a positive drug test.

The supporting letter from the examining physician must be included in the supporting documentation as this will help you to file an appeal in-case of a positive drug test.

The Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) Supporting Physician Letter is on the Geneva College Athletic Training Website. Follow these steps to complete the required NCAA paperwork:

- Print the ADHD Physician Form from the Geneva College Athletic Training Website
- Have the form completed in its entirety by your examining physician
- Return the completed form to the Athletic Training Faculty prior to the start of your athletic participation at Geneva College.

These guidelines are also in effect for the use of 'Finasteride' for the treatment of male pattern baldness and medications used to treat hypogonadism.
