



Completing the Pennsylvania State Grant Form

Pennsylvania residents may be eligible to receive a PA State Grant, which is funding that is paid in part or in whole by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is administered by the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA). However, to be considered for the Pennsylvania State Grant, you must complete your Pennsylvania State Grant Form (i.e. the State Grant application).

To be considered for the Pennsylvania State Grant, which is money that you do not repay, please complete the following steps to create your account:

1. Go to PHEAA's website, <https://www.pheaa.org/>.
2. Click "Sign In" then click "Borrowers/Students."
3. Click "Continue to AES Account Access."
4. Create an account or sign in using your account log in information.
5. Continue through the remaining steps to create your account. Make sure to answer all the questions that you are asked and sign the application electronically at the end of the process.
