

Completing the Pennsylvania Summer State Grant Application

Pennsylvania residents <u>may</u> be eligible to receive a PA State Grant, which is funding that is paid in part or in whole by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is administered by the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA). In addition, Pennsylvania residents are welcome to apply for the Pennsylvania Summer State Grant Program, which is a separate application from the regular PA State Grant Form (i.e., PA State Grant application).

To apply for the Pennsylvania Summer State Grant Program, please visit PHEAA's website, https://pheaa.org. Please keep the following considerations in mind as you apply for the Summer Grant:

- 1. You must be enrolled at least half-time (six credits or more) in the summer term.
- There is a maximum number of grant payments that a student can receive from PHEAA (eight full-time semesters, sixteen part-time semesters, or a combination of both).
 Receiving a Summer Grant will be count towards the maximum grants allowed.
- 3. If your Financial Aid Portal (https://finaid.geneva.edu) indicates "PHEAA Summer Application" as a missing document, this means that the Student Financial Services Staff has reviewed your State Grant and academic record and has determined that you may be a good candidate to receive the grant. Please contact Student Financial Services for more information or concerns.
- 4. Please keep in mind that the application opens annually mid-March, and the deadline to apply is August 15th.
