



## Completing PHEAA's Income Validation Review

Pennsylvania residents may be eligible to receive a PA State Grant, which is funding that is paid in part or in whole by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is administered by the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA). However, to be considered for the Pennsylvania State Grant, you must complete your Pennsylvania State Grant Form (i.e. the State Grant application).

If your account is being reviewed by PHEAA, **please monitor your mail and email for notifications from PHEAA explaining the review process and the documentation that is needed in order to finalize your State Grant eligibility.**

Please note that Geneva College will not disburse your PHEAA grant to your student account until PHEAA has completed the review. Additionally, disbursement is dependent on PHEAA's determination of your grant eligibility. **We encourage you to submit any requested documentation to PHEAA as soon as possible**, so that PHEAA can finalize your grant eligibility prior to the start of your semester.

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
