<u>Word</u>

Read the following verses together!

- Luke 6:45, Mark 7:21, Proverbs 27:19, Jeremiah 17:9, Ezekiel 36:26-28, Psalm 51:10
- What do these passages tell us about ourselves?
- What do these passages tell us about God's heart?

<u>World</u>

- What does the world say about our hearts? Share real examples (Valentine's Day, etc.)
- How is the world's understanding of our heart different from how God describes it?
- Would you say your view of your own heart is more like the world's or how God describes it?

<u>Us</u>

2 Thessalonians 3:5 - "May the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the steadfastness of Christ"

God wants to make our hearts whole. As we experience wholeness, our bodies follow.

- In what specific ways has God transformed your heart and given you Kingdom desires? (death to life moments)
- Are there parts of your heart you are afraid to give to him?
- What small things can you do this week to recalibrate and turn your heart towards Him?
- How can we lean on one another?
