JOB DESCRIPTION

Summary of Responsibilities: Assists the head coach of soccer with overall management of the soccer program including recruiting, counseling, practices and games and other related duties.

Essential Responsibilities: (These essential responsibilities are those the individual must be able to perform unaided or with the assistance of reasonable accommodation.)

- A. This list is meant to be representative, not exhaustive. Some graduate assistants may not perform all the duties listed while in other cases related duties may also be assigned.
- Knowledgeable of, and compliance with, Geneva College, PAC, and NCAA Division III rules and regulations.
- Models Christian attitudes and behaviors for student athletes, students, staff, and fans.
- Demonstrates concern for the spiritual, academic, physical, and emotional well-being of each team member.
- Assists the Coach in the management of the assigned sport, attending all games and practices in the regular season and the off-season.
- Assists in recruiting student athletes.
- Assists in designing practice and game plans.
- Assists with the management of athletic equipment.
- ❖ Assists in preparation of soccer field for practices and games.
- ❖ May serve specifically as coach in a special aspect of the sport.
- Maintain effective working relationships with coaches, student-athletes, and other staff.

Secondary Responsibilities: (These are responsibilities that may be delegated in order to make reasonable accommodation for an employee)

A. Perform related duties as assigned.

Performance Development Areas will include: Communication, Job/Technical Knowledge, Teamwork/Cooperation, Initiative/Interest/Motivation, Adaptability/Flexibility, Stewardship and Safety.

Christian Commitment: Assistant must be a thoughtful and articulate Christian and an active member of a Christian evangelical church.
