

Managing Your Student Account at Geneva College

Step 1: Make sure that your financial aid has been accepted and all documents finalized at https://finaid.geneva.edu

Step 2: View your Nelnet student account at https://my.geneva.edu/

- You will receive an email notification when your eBill is ready to be viewed. It is the responsibility of the registered student to accurately maintain their student account and to ensure all bills are paid on time.
- Once you have logged in to your MyGeneva account you will manage all aspects of your student account from receiving eBills, making on-line payments, setting up payment plans, checking your student account balances and managing Student Choice Refunds, and much more.
- Click on the Student Information Tab and then on the Student Financial Services Page.
- Go to my Nelnet Account (bottom of page)

- Health Insurance is mandatory for Traditional Undergraduate Students and will cost \$974 for the Spring if you purchase coverage through Geneva's health plan. If you are covered under your parent's policy, please waive coverage at https://www.universityhealthplans.com/geneva to remove this charge before January 11th, 2019.

Step 3: If you want your parents, spouse, grandparents, or other parties to be able to see your eBill, make online payments to your account, or set up a Payment Plan on your behalf you will need to add them to your Nelnet account as an Authorized Party.

- They will receive an invitation from Nelnet to set up their own account that will give them access without having to go through your MyGeneva account.

Step 4: Set Up a Payment Plan until January 2nd or pay your Fall bill before the program deadline. (Note: **Payment plan enrollment is on a per-semester basis**. If you signed up for Fall, you will **not** be automatically enrolled for Spring.)

- Payment plans are <u>not</u> available for students in the CUBM, Masters in Business Administration or Masters of Higher Education Programs at this time.
- All payment plans will be set up through your Nelnet account. From the Home page click on "Enroll in Payment Plan". Complete instructions to set up a Payment Plan can be found at http://www.geneva.edu/student-financial-services/tuition-costs-billing/nelnet-faq.
- 4-month plan for Spring (enroll between 11/30/18 1/2/19), payments run from January April, requires 10% down payment
- 5-month plan for Spring (enroll between 11/30/18 12/27/18), payments run from December April, no down payment required
- Payment Methods: Automatic bank payment (checking account only) or credit card/debit card (an additional convenience fee of 2.75% will be assessed)
- Payments are processed on the date that you select at the time of enrolling in the plan.
- Cost to Participate: \$25 enrollment fee per semester, \$30 returned payment fee if a payment is returned

- Note: Other charges (ex. parking tickets, Chapel fines, housing fees) cannot be included in a payment plan and are due in full when they are billed.
