



Tuition was due by August 10, 2020 and is now Past Due!

Just a reminder that all tuition not covered by financial aid or grants/scholarships was due and payable by Monday, August 10, 2020. If you have not made your tuition payment, please make arrangements to do so at this time. Your payment options are to make an online payment through your Nelnet account; mail a check to Geneva College; set up a payment plan through your Nelnet account; secure a private loan that is certified by Geneva College. Deadline for Enrollment in a Payment Plan is August 20, 2020

If you are registered as a full-time undergraduate student, you are eligible to enroll in a monthly, interest free payment plan to assist you in paying your fall semester balance. Please note that you are required to sign up for the full outstanding balance on your student account; payments will be automatically deducted from your bank account or credit card; and payment plans must be set up through your Nelnet account. There is a 4-month plan. A \$25.00 Non-Refundable enrollment fee due at the time you enroll in the plan. Also, if you choose the 4-month plan there is a 10% down payment of the balance due at time of enrollment. Deadline to Remove Charge is September 4, 2020

If you are still seeing a charge of \$1,761.00 for Student Health Insurance on your student account, it means that Geneva College has not received a Waiver Form from you to remove the charge. If you are covered by insurance through another policy, we encourage you to complete and submit the form at this time. Once we receive and process your waiver, Geneva College will remove the insurance charge from your student account and update your balance due. ***Deadline to have this charge removed from your student account is September 4, 2020. A waiver form must be submitted by this date.***
