



Finalize your financial aid by completing the following steps

ALL STUDENTS

- ✓ **Accept your aid** Log into MyGenevaAid (our financial aid manager) at <https://finaid.geneva.edu> to accept your aid. See your Award Notification email for instructions.
- ✓ **Finish the requirements for Direct Loans**

If you choose to borrow the loans listed on your award and are a first time borrower, please complete the following:

 - Direct Loan Entrance Counseling
 - Direct Loan Master Promissory Note

Both can be completed by signing into <https://studentloans.gov>. You will need your Federal Student Aid ID to complete this. Please call Direct Loan Applicant Services with any questions: 1.800.557.7394.

Also note: The US Dept. of Education will charge a fee for processing your loans and will deduct these amounts before disbursement to the student account. For more information about the interest rates and fees on these loans, please see <https://studentloans.gov>.
- ✓ **Selected for FAFSA Verification?** If you were selected for verification, you will need to complete a verification worksheet and send it back with supporting documentation. Please read it carefully and send the requested documents as soon as possible.
- ✓ **PA Residents: Check on your state grant** If you are a PA resident, create an account at www.pheaa.org and click on "View State Grant Status" or call 1.800.692.7392. (Not available for graduate programs)
- ✓ **Paying your bill** Geneva College will send a notification to your Geneva email address prior to the beginning of the term, giving instruction on how to access your student account/bill through MyGeneva/NetNet. Be sure to plan how you will pay any remaining balance ahead of time. If anyone other than the student needs access to your bill, please add them as an authorized payer through MyGeneva/NetNet.
- ✓ **Don't forget about the cost of books** **Please plan to save money for books before each semester** if they are not included in your program costs. If you receive a refund from your aid, it will not be processed until after the term has begun, and cannot be relied upon to be available for books.
- ✓ **Did you receive money from other sources?** Notify Student Financial Services of any private scholarships, VA benefits or other funds you expect to receive. Email us at SFS@geneva.edu. Geneva College reserves the right to revise your award if you receive private scholarships and funds not listed on your award notification.

ADDITIONAL OPTIONS FOR PAYING FOR COLLEGE

- ✓ **Apply for Additional Loans**

If you are interested in borrowing additional loans, there are two options for those who qualify:

 - Direct Parent PLUS Loans (apply online at <https://studentloans.gov>)
 - Private Student Loans (get more details at http://www.geneva.edu/student-financial-services/aid-types/private_edu_loans)

Please be sure to apply early and for the amount needed for the entire year. If loan changes need to be made after approval, please notify us in writing.

ON CAMPUS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

- ✓ **Enroll in the Payment Plan** Details on all plans and payment options can be found at www.geneva.edu/student-financial-services/tuition-costs-billing/nelnet-faq or by calling Student Financial Services (724.847.6530). Enrollment in the **interest free** monthly payment plan begins in July and ends in August for the Fall semester, so please sign up early! Enrollment for a Spring plan opens in December and ends in January. There is a \$25 enrollment fee per semester.
